Marine Engineers – MED I

Mates

Key responsibilities will include:

- Liaise between the ships master and the crew whilst supervising crew
- Plan & coordinate safe & secure cargo handling
- Liaise with the master & deck crew to execute effective loading and deliveries

It is essential that applicants possess a Master Class 5 (Trading) ticket, a forklift licence, have experience with regard to the cargo receipt, consolidation and dispatching processes.
