



Dear Visitors & Truck Drivers

At Sea Swift, we prioritise safety. To maintain a safe environment, Sea Swift has mandatory PPE requirements for all workers, including visitors and truck drivers.

If you visit a Sea Swift site and enter our operational areas (including designated driver waiting zones), you must wear a high visibility vest.

High visibility or reflective vests (hi-vis) and correct footwear play a crucial role in ensuring the safety of all individuals present in Sea Swift depot areas. Hi-vis vests keep you visible to our operators.

Help us to manage safety on our operational sites by complying with the following Sea Swift Safety requirements:

1. Always wear a high visibility vest while inside the Sea Swift depot premises, **including** the driver's waiting zone. This requirement is applicable regardless of the time of day, weather conditions, or if there are other trucks loading or unloading. Even if there are no other deliveries when you are in the depot, your vest must still be worn.
2. Ensure that your high visibility vest is securely fastened on your person for maximum visibility. The vest should conform with safety standards.
3. Keep an extra high visibility vest in your truck in case of damage or loss of the original vest. If you are without a compliant vest, you may not be allowed to exit your vehicle.
4. All passengers who accompany you must wear a high visibility vest when entering the operational area.
5. Ensure you are wearing closed footwear at a minimum to enter the operational depot. You may not be able to enter without appropriate footwear.

By following these simple requirements, we can collectively maintain a safe environment for all. We appreciate your cooperation.
